Thank you for your time and interest in TVO's Independent Learning Centre (ILC). I'm thrilled to formalize our recent business relationship with London Language Institute (LLI), and look forward to working together to provide international students access to our highly acclaimed Ontario education.

As you know, TVO is an agency of the Ontario government, the most populous province in Canada. We are the technological extension of the public education system in Ontario, running a renowned public broadcaster and delivering innovative educational products. Among these is the ILC, Ontario's largest high school, with more than 20,000 students taking distance-learning courses toward their diploma or as pre-requisites for post-secondary programming. The ILC has been operated by the province of Ontario since 1926.
